## **REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

1. This request for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice for the Dar es Salaam Metropolitan Development Project that appeared in the UN Development Business online of April 22, 2015.
2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Dar es Salaam Metropolitan Development Project. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the credit will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for the Provision of Consultancy Services for Preparation of a Drainage and Sanitation Development Plan (DSDP) for Dar es Salaam for Period 2018-2035 under the Dar es Salaam Metropolitan Development Project (DMDP), coordinated by the President's Office, Regional Administration and Local Government (PO-RALG).
3. The primary Objective of the assignment is to develop an integrated Drainage and Sanitation Development Plan. A second objective is to propose an initial project, to a conceptual engineering level, of about 5 years duration which would implement the first priorities identified in the Plan. This priority project should be prepared such that it could be presented to donors for possible support. The Drainage and Sanitation Development Plan (DSDP) will cover storm water drainage, wastewater collection and treatment and septage management. The DSDP Plan will cover the period from 2018 to 2035 and it should define institutional, structural and non-structural measures needed to develop, operate and maintain drainage and wastewater systems within the DSM Metropolitan area. Improvements in wastewater

collection through better drainage systems will also strengthen flood management and that should be elaborated in the DSDP.

4. The DSDP should take stock of the progress made in the previous plans and proposals (e.g. interventions proposed under the Flood Control and Drainage Component of the just commenced DMDP). The DSDP should of course be fully integrated with the Dar es Salaam Master Plan (currently in draft stage) and other relevant urban and sectoral plans. The Consultant's team will comprise experts with international experience (Team Leader – Civil Engineer, Drainage Engineer, Wastewater Engineer and Financial Expert/Economist) and several other support staff (local and some part time staff).
5. The Permanent Secretary, PO-RALG, now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
6. The short listing criteria are: (i) Successfully completed similar assignments in the study, planning and design of comprehensive storm water, combined drainage systems and wastewater and fecal sludge collection and treatment systems in major cities, including in developing countries; (ii) Demonstrated experience in carrying out feasibility or preparation studies and engineering design of relevant infrastructure projects., (iii) Excellent team composition to perform the services, including drainage and wastewater engineering, planning, urban development, and economics.
7. Information to be provided should include name of assignment, name and full contact address of the client, role of consultant if lead, joint venture or sub-consultant, input of the consultant in the assignment, assignment value, duration, dates/period of execution of assignment, etc. Consultants are advised not to submit brochures or other extraneous documents; instead to extract any relevant/important information and include this in the information to be provided as guided in the preceding sentence in fulfilment of Client's desire to limit quantities of materials/document pages in the expression of interest.

Firms may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

8. This is **not** a request for proposals (**RFP**). After a review of the expressions of interest, a shortlist will be prepared and the short-listed consultants will be invited to submit their proposals through a letter of invitation including specific terms of reference. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers* [current edition] ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. A consulting firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
